

Edwards Center CLS program guidelines for public health risk

In the event that tri-met lift goes into “life sustaining” rides only, all CLS programs will be closed and will not re-open until management has deemed it safe to do so.

We continue to closely monitor advisories issued by Federal, State and Local authorities. In the event the Oregon Health Authority or the Center for Disease Control advise that Oregon residents stay home, Edwards Center CLS programs will take the following actions:

If the advisory is announced before program hours, Edwards Center will not open programs until advisory is over.

If the advisory is announced during program hours, CLS staff will start calling homes and tri-met to get all participants home. Edwards programs will then stay closed and not re-open until advisory is lifted.

In the event that the center itself is ordered to shelter in place, we will follow shelter in place protocols along with directions from the OHA or CDC.
