

Childcare Assistance for DSPs

- DSPs can call 2-1-1 and they will direct “essential workers” to child care providers who are designated to prioritize and save space to meet the child care needs of essential workers. Wait for the CHILD CARE prompt for an expedited process. You can also email: children@211info.org
- In addition, if not already, DSPs should be encouraged to sign up for the emergency child care subsidy. The state has increased the income eligibly for this program, and waived all family co-pay requirements so parents who qualify will receive fully subsidized child care. There is also a process to get their current child care provider qualified (and paid by the State).
